I. Love One Another, V11

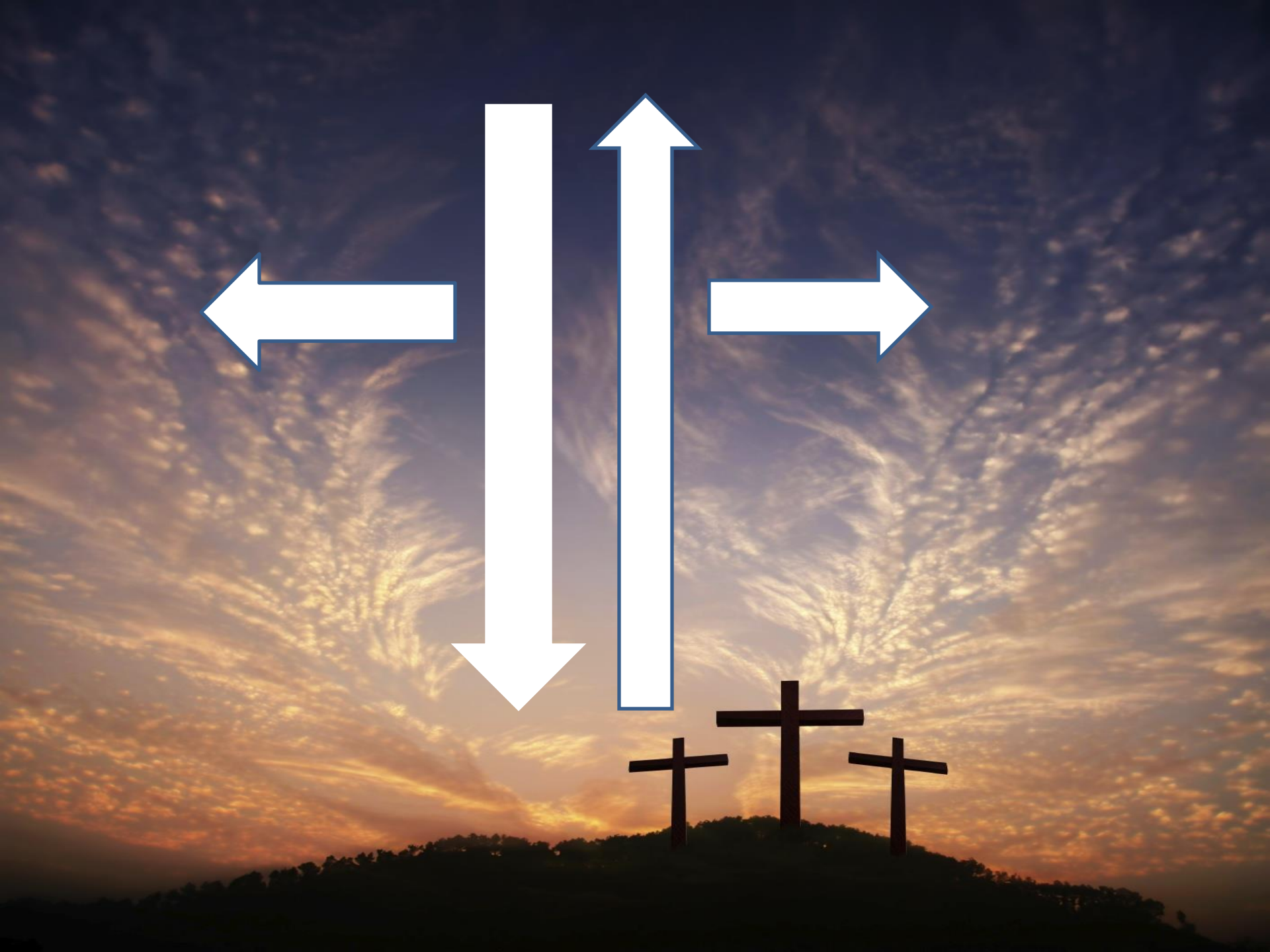
¹¹ For this is the message

who belonged to the evil one

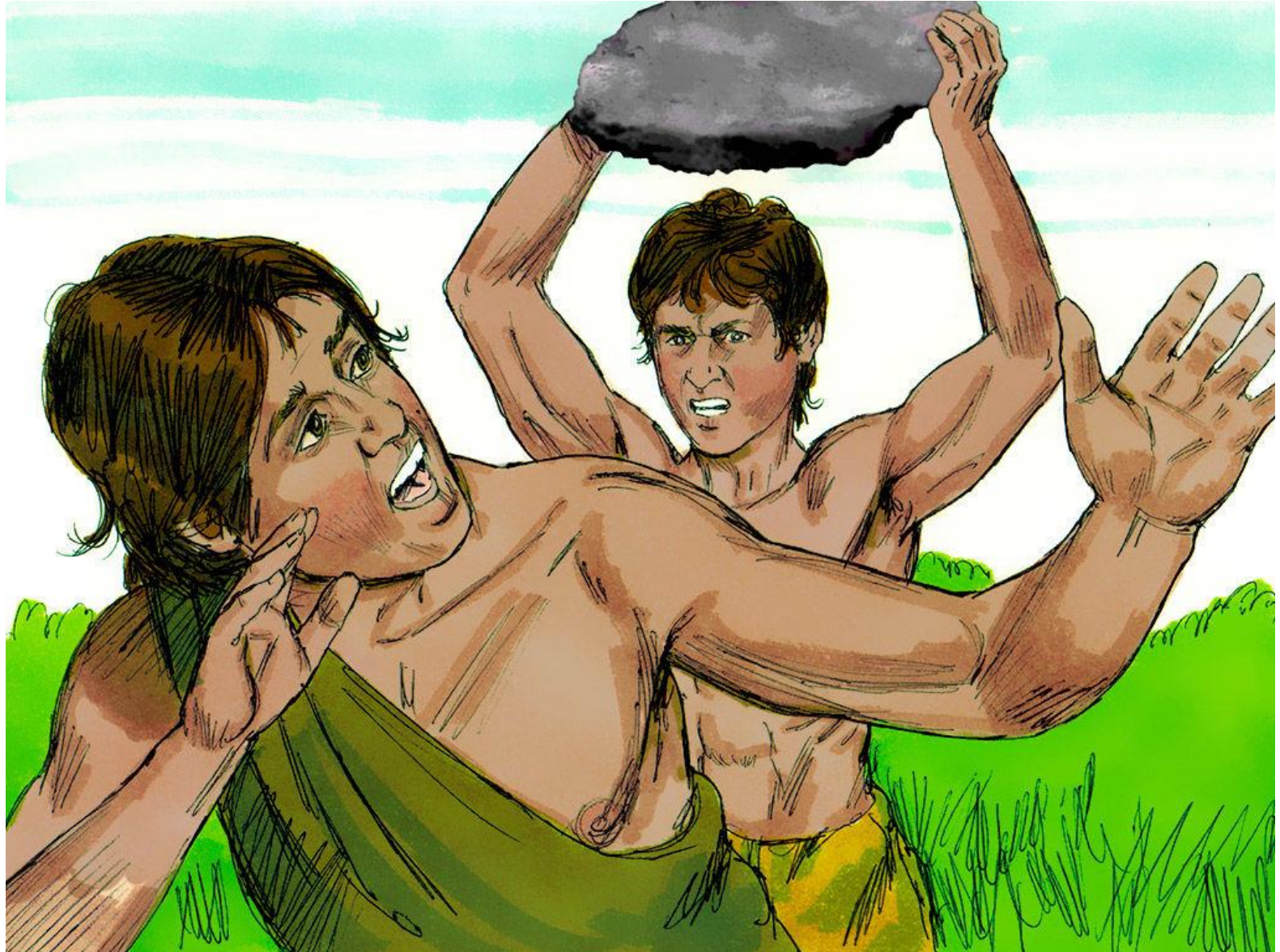
and murdered his brother.

II. MURDER AND HATRED, v13

¹³ Do not be surprised,
my brothers and sisters,
if the world hates you.

I met Jesus at the cross roads,

Where the two ways meet;

But I said 'No! there's Jesus here,

Just see what He offers me:

II. MURDER AND HATRED, v14

14 We know that we have passed
from death to life,
because we love each other.
Anyone who does not love
remains in death

“Love” means life and refusal to love means death.

II. MURDER AND HATRED, v15

¹⁵ Anyone who hates a brother or sister
is a murderer,
and you know that no murderer
has eternal life residing in him.

Christianity begins in the heart, outward
compliance alone is not sufficient.

“There's murder in their hearts.
You'd better be glad the bars are there.”



"May their souls rest in hell and suffer the torments of the condemned for eternity."

Jesus Christ laid down his life for us.
And we ought to lay down our lives

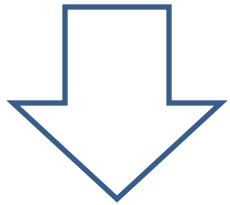

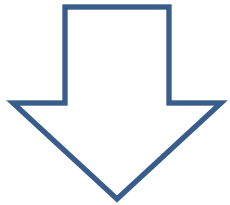
¹⁷ If anyone has material possessions and sees (behold) a brother or sister in need but has no pity on them,
