<sup>20</sup> If our hearts condemn us, we know that God is greater than our hearts, and he knows everything



<sup>22</sup> and receive from him anything we ask, because we keep his commands and do what pleases him


# Loving one another is also a prerequisite to answered prayer.




# What is Prayer?
