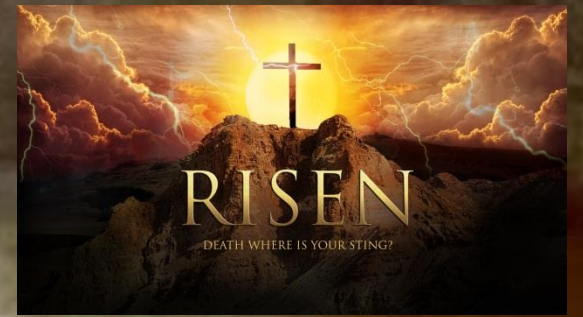

- 2. The grave is not the final end, for you or loved ones. 坟墓不是对于你或亲人最后的结局。**
- 3. We love, we worship, and we serve a risen Savior. 我们爱，我们崇拜，我们事奉复活的救主。**
