




Unplanned Reunion of Joseph's brother


"Dad, You're not going to believe this."





A. Pharaoh's Acceptance

Gen 45:16 When the news reached Pharaoh's palace that Joseph's brothers had come, Pharaoh and all his officials were pleased.




17 Pharaoh said to Joseph, "Tell your brothers, 'Do this: Load your animals and return to the land of Canaan, 18 and bring your father and your families back to me. I will give you the best of the land of Egypt and you can enjoy the fat of the land.'

A. Pharaoh's Acceptance

Gen 45:19 "You are also directed to tell them, 'Do this: Take some carts from Egypt for your children and your wives, and get your father and come.

20 Never mind about your belongings, because the best

of all Egypt will be yours."



B. Joseph's Provisions

Gen 45:22 To each of them he gave new clothing, but to Benjamin he gave three hundred shekels of silver and five sets of clothes.




And this is what he sent to his father: ten donkeys loaded with the best things of Egypt, and ten female donkeys loaded with grain and bread and other

C. Jacob's Response


Gen 45:25 So they went up out of Egypt and came to their father Jacob in the land of Canaan.

²⁶ They told him, "Joseph is still alive! In fact, he is ruler of all Egypt." Jacob was stunned; he did not

believe them.


C. Jacob's Response

Gen 45:27 But when they told him everything Joseph had said to them, and when he saw the carts Joseph had sent to carry him back, the spirit of their father Jacob revived.



Gen 45:28 And Israel said, "I'm convinced! My son Joseph is still alive. I will go and see him before I die."

II. JOURNEY FROM CANAAN TO EGYPT




Gen 46:1 So Israel set out with all that was his, and when he reached Beersheba, he offered sacrifices to the God of his father Isaac.

2 And God spoke to Israel in a vision at night and said, "Jacob! Jacob!" "Here I am," he replied.

3 "I am God, the God of your father," he said.
"Do not be afraid to go down to Egypt, for I will make you into a great nation there.

4 I will go down to Egypt with you, and I will surely bring you back again. And Joseph's own hand will close your eyes."

Gen 46:29 Joseph had his chariot made ready and went to Goshen to meet his father Israel. As soon as Joseph appeared before him, he threw his arms around his father

and wept for a long time.


30 Israel said to Joseph, "Now I am ready to die, since I have seen for myself that you are still alive."


It gives us the Blessed Hope of reuniting with our love ones who are temporary separated.
