Mission - Bro Calvin Choong

Ongoing project:

- o Liaising with Jonathan Loh for a mission trip to visit the Orang Asli ministry.
- o Looking into reaching out to a refugee center in Pudu, as he is in touch with his friend who have an NGO teaching refugee student. He is looking into how the mission ministry can come in to reach out to the students as well as the parents.

Ps Bobby suggest to get in touch with Ps Glenn as he works with disperse groups (refugees) and partner with him in his ministry.

SOCIAL MEDICAL

- Bro Peter Chow shares the challenges he faces in this ministry
- Not enough volunteers' doctors ever since Dr Khoo left. Dr Mae Lynn express interest to help but he was unsure since she is a specialist
- The availability of the community hall in Cheras Ria is inconsistence and even though it is available it is difficult to obtain the key. The management is not well managed and due to that the social medical service was called off.
- Due to the inconsistency in opening, people are unsure thus attendance is not encouraging.

There was suggestion to operate a mobile unit but may face trouble with authorities. Bro Peter proposes to move the social medical operation to HCBC new wing since the place in conducive and available. Since they have all former patient contact in a WhatsApp's group, they can inform them when social medical service is in operation.

He hopes to have more publicity to recruit doctors.

They have written to the health ministry with regard to the operations of the Social Medical service and since there are no rules governing helping community they will not interfered.
